

## Music Guidelines for Weddings & Funerals at WIUC

Thank you for choosing to have your service at Williston-Immanuel United Church. Our campus is blessed with a beautiful Sanctuary, housing an impressive pipe organ and two grand pianos. Our Director of Music & Organist, Matthew Emkey, is happy to help you plan the music he will play for your liturgy. Assistant Director of Music & Accompanist, Denise Calkins, is also available to play upon your request.

Here are the Musician Fees for liturgies held at WIUC:

- **Wedding Ceremony – \$300 (one musician)**
- **Funeral or Memorial Service - \$250 (one musician)**
- **Wedding Ceremony Musician Fee with approved outside musician - \$150 (see requirements below)**
- **Funeral or Memorial Service Musician Fee with approved outside musician - \$125 (see requirements below)**
  
- Attendance at a wedding rehearsal is an additional \$75, subject to musician availability
- The Musician Fee is comprehensive and includes all preludes, postludes, processionals, recessionals, and music during the service itself. Also included are planning and consultation, as well as the cost of additional sheet music needed.
- 50% of the Musician Fee is due at the time the event is booked. The remaining 50% is due one week prior to the event (for weddings), and 50% the day of the event (for funerals or memorial services)
- All fees are to be made directly to the musician(s). Check or Venmo are the preferred payment methods
- Any outside musicians must be approved by the Director of Music & Organist and are to be compensated separately. If you prefer to use outside musicians *in place* of the WIUC musicians, 50% of the Musician Fee will still need to be paid.
- While we will do our best, WIUC musicians may not be able to accommodate all music requests. Please contact us as soon as possible to allow time to plan, prepare, and procure sheet music
- Musician Fees are for one WIUC musician only. Additional musician(s) available at additional cost(s)
